

The Rhythm Guitar




Variations: Many great rock riffs are based upon picking out the individual notes of the power chords.

The Blues Scale in A

Use the following scale to improvise your own solos to the power-chord sequence shown above. (If you remove the notes shown in parenthesis, the A blues scale becomes the A minor pentatonic scale.)





Higher and lower extensions: You can also extend the blues scale by using the notes in the higher and lower positions shown below.
